
Community

In 2014, the small engineering team at Nativo had zero visibility into system performance and inadequate monitoring in place. Today, the Elastic Stack is a mission-critical system at Nativo, ingesting data from more than 30 applications, generating 150 million documents, and consuming 225 GB each day across four Amazon Web Services regions.

In this talk, hear how the team and their implementation of the Elastic Stack evolved over the past three years. Learn best practices — such as enriching logs before leaving the instance and standardizing applications logs as JSON — that have contributed to the team's success. Plus, see how they're addressing new challenges like improving index management.
